The “Save The Campbell” campaign (<https://SaveTheCampbell.com/>) is working to stop the May 2025 closure of the Campbell plant in Port Sheldon Township which provides reliable, affordable electric to 1 million consumers in the region, and transitioning our electric to solar and wind which are not. This kicks off our petition drive to get Ottawa County the local control via a County Charter it needs to stop the closure and demolition of the Campbell plant.

The “Save The Campbell” campaign is also helping the petition drive of Citizens for Local Choice which is a ballot initiative aimed at amending a recent Michigan act which stripped away local control of large scale utility land-use projects for solar and wind (<https://www.micitizenschoice.org/take-action>). Experts with the Michigan Public Service Commission estimate Michigan may need to dedicate 209,000 more acres of land to wind and solar development. Township zoning rights should not be infringed, so we are helping with its petition drive as well.
